Dear families,

We have been looking at the homework we set your child, and whether it is linked to our school priorities in order to raise attainment and ensure every child reaches their potential. In order to maximise the learning support from home and the potential of online learning, we have decided that the majority of homework is best supported through online packages. As a result of this, your child will be expected to do the following at home:

- Reception- Maths and English on Tapestry and weekly phonics sheet.
- Year 1- Maths on Purple Mash, spellings and three lots of reading at home.
- Year 2- TT Rockstars, spellings and three lots of reading at home.
- KS2- TT Rockstars, Reading Plus, spellings and three lots of reading at home.

Your child's new teacher will ensure that you know what is expected and children can still attend homework club to complete the online packages or spellings above. However, it is essential that your child reads with you or any members of the family as much as possible with a minimum of 3 times per week.

Topic webs and knowledge organisers will still be sent out to inform you of the learning that is happening in school and we encourage you to support your child with this. Additional educational websites are also listed on our website as required. Please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher if you have any queries.
