Dear Parents and Carers,

Milk and Snack in school

We are very much looking forward to welcoming our students back into school from September 1st.

I am writing to inform you of some changes we are making to our provision of milk and fruit snacks across school. Currently all our Nursery and Reception students receive free milk and snack daily in school and this will continue next year.

Milk – Year 1 and 2 parents (KS1) will have the option of paying for daily milk for their child. This must be paid in advance for the year at a cost of £31.50 through the usual ParentPay system, unless your child is entitled to benefit-related free school meals. All KS1 and KS2 students will have water bottles provided free of charge by school and have access to unlimited drinking water all day.

Snack – a piece of fruit or vegetables will be provided free of charge each day to all our Early Years, Year 1 and Year 2 students. Snack will not be provided for KS2 students (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6), however they are welcome to bring a piece of fresh fruit to school to eat at playtime. This is fresh fruit only – not fruit sweet bars or other products.

We are a healthy school and we want to promote healthy eating and excellent dental care.

As always, we are grateful for your support and look forward to seeing you all again next week.
