Year 4 and Year 5 are being offered a 3 day, 2 nights Robinwood residential at Dobroyd Castle Activity Centre in Todmorden. This is an exciting opportunity to experience time away from home, enhance the Summer term curriculum theme, and, undertake a number of thrilling indoor and outdoor activities:

- Zip Wire
- Piranha Pool
- Nightline
- Trapeze
- Canoeing
- Archery

The children will be accompanied by teachers and learning support assistants and there will also be a First Aider with the group at all times. Boys and girls will have separate rooms and our staff will be staying in their own rooms near to the children.

The cost of the visit is £115 which includes accommodation, food and the cost of all activities, as well as transport to and from Dobroyd Castle. School has substantially subsidised the trip and transport costs to make this experience affordable.
