Dear families

The children in Year 1 are going on a visit to Bradford Industrial Museum on:

Friday 11th March 2022

The visit is linked to a topic about old toys, which is part of the work the children are doing in school. A packed lunch will be ordered from the school kitchen for all children.

The school is meeting some of the costs, but we are also asking for voluntary contribution of **£6.00** per child towards the cost of the workshop and coach. However, I must point out that if insufficient payments are made the visit may have to be cancelled. As we have to pay the full cost of the trip and coach in advance, we are unable to offer a refund if your child does not attend due to holiday or illness.

If your child uses an inhaler or any other medication on a regular basis please make sure that they bring it with on the day of the trip.

If you know your child does not travel well please give them a sickness tablet **before** setting off for school in the morning, and bring another one in a labelled envelope so we can give it to them before setting off for home in the evening.

Please make sure your child comes to school in their **uniform**, have sensible footwear and a warm coat as the weather may be cold. The children will be leaving at:

9:45 a.m. and returning by 2:15 p.m.

Please collect your child as normal at home-time.
