Alternative porcine (pork gelatine) free flu injection offer for primary aged children in reception to year 6

Flu vaccination is being offered to your child. Most children are offered a nasal spray vaccine which is easy to administer and is considered better at preventing the spread of flu.

The nasal vaccine contains highly processed porcine (pork) gelatine as an essential stabiliser. For those who may not accept the use of porcine gelatine in medicines, a flu vaccine injection is available. If you have not already done so and would like to consent to the flu injection, please follow the steps in the guide at the end of this letter.

Once we receive your consent form a member of the team will be in touch to offer your child an appointment at one of our clinics. These are held at various times and dates which include some Saturdays at:

Horton Park Centre - Undercliffe Health Centre - Keighley Health Centre

You do not need to complete a consent form if your child has already received their Flu vaccination this winter, or you have already completed your online consent form for the Flu nasal spray/injection.
