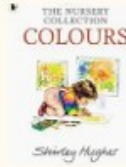

cherries.



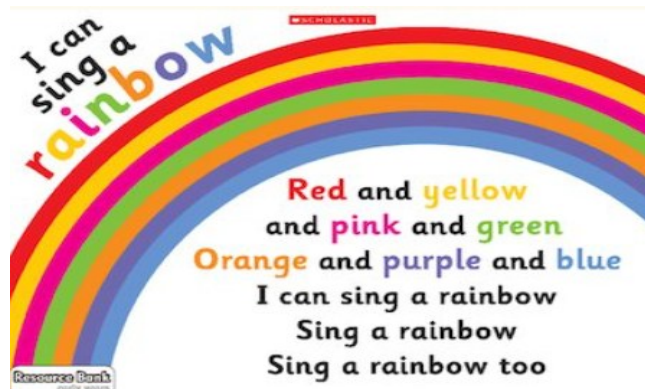

Communication & Language

- *Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens.
- *Use a wider range of vocabulary.
- *Sing a large repertoire of songs.
- *Know many rhymes, be able to talk about familiar books, and be able to tell a long story.

Literacy

- *Understand the five key concepts about print: - print has meaning - print can have different purposes - we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom - the names of the different parts of a book - page sequencing.
- *Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.

Maths

- *Develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually ('subitising').
- *Recite numbers past 5.
- *Say one number for each item in order: 1,2,3,4,5.

Understanding of the world

- *Use all their senses in hands-on exploration of natural materials.
- *Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary.
