This terms topic is 'Transport'



This half term our topic will be Transport, and our focus story will be 'The Train Ride'.

We'll be exploring all things trains — learning fun facts, re-enacting the story, and even taking part in our very own virtual train ride! The classroom will be transformed into a train, complete with seats, numbers, and roles such as the train driver and ticket collector. Each child will be given a special ticket and will match it to the correct seat number to enjoy their journey!

In Maths, we'll be learning about 2D shapes and their properties. The children will use shapes to create different types of transport and will go on a shape hunt around the school to discover what shapes we can find in everyday objects.

It's going to be an exciting start to the half term, full of fun, imagination, and lots of learning!

Creative Curriculum



As part of our Creative Curriculum, the children will be going on a real train ride — just like in our story Train Ride!

Afternoon children: Tuesday 24th March

We'll be travelling by train from Bradford Forster Square Station to Saltaire Station, then taking a short walk to Roberts Park (weather permitting).

This exciting experience will help bring our story and learning to life, giving children a real sense of adventure and understanding of how people travel by train.
