# This terms topic is 'Under the sea'.

In English we will be focusing on books called 'Rainbow Fish, Commotion in the Ocean and other non-fiction books. We will be using puppets and props to re-enact and recall the story. We will also be concentrating on pencil grip and pencil control as we continue 'writing our name' in our daily routine.

In Maths we will be recapping 2D shapes, learning 3D shapes. We will also be counting and representing numbers 1-5, using language such as more than, less than and counting and ordering numbers 1-5.

To enrich our curriculum this half term we will be starting off with looking at activities that mark the end of Ramadan and the celebration of Eid -ul-Fitr.
