English

Reading

We will be focusing our activities each week around the story Room on a Broom by Julia Don aldson

Please can you discuss this book with your children by asking about the characters, setting and the problems.

We will be focusing on the new vocabulary and discussing the words me. You could visit a library and borrow the book or together you could watch it being read on YouTube.

<u>Writing</u>

In literacy we will be retelling stories, writing words, labels and simple sentences.

Maths

In maths we will be learning the numbers up to 5. We will be able to recognise the number and represent the numbers in different ways.

We will also be learning about circles, triangles and shapes with 4 sides.

Creative

Children will be exploring a range of materials to create art work. They will make wands, hats, painting and potions.

Festivals

The children will be learning about different festivals, Halloween, bonfire night and Christmas.

Phonics

Daily phonics lessons will continue and the children will be taught a specific sound a day and are beginning to blend to read words.

Children will be encouraged to read and write cvc words, captions and simple sentences
