School Uniform

We expect all children to wear school uniform at Dixons Marchbank as it fosters a sense of belonging and community. Our school uniform expectations are outlined below.

Uniform

Purple jumper or cardigan with logo

Grey long trousers, skirt, pinafore dress or shalwar kameez

White shirt

Black, purple or grey hijab - elasticated and plain

Plain flat, black shoes (no logos, stripes or wheels)

Purple Marchbank school bag with logo or small rucksack of choice

Transparent water bottle, labelled with name & class

Please make sure your child has a coat for the playground. If boots are worn in winter, a change of shoes should be sent to school to be worn inside the building.



Plain white t-shirt

Plain black or grey shorts

Plain black or grey tracksuit bottoms

Purple cardigan, jumper or hoody with logo

Plain black trainers

Where incorrect uniform is worn, families will be contacted to provide the correct item. A supply of pumps is kept in school and your child will be asked to wear them until correct footwear is provided. All uniform items should have your child's name written clearly in them.

Jewellery

Jewellery must not be worn to school other than one small stud in each ear. Children who wear watches must take full responsibility for them. Smart watches which may contain cameras or recording equipment are not allowed.

Hairstyling

Shaved patterns in hair are not acceptable in school.
