

Writing

Your child will continue to learn how to write in different formats. They will learn how to write a recount of our trip to the Industrial Museum. They will also look at poetry and create an Eid poem. Our sentence work will include capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We are continuing to use the conjunction 'and' in our sentences. We will we also continue using the 'suffixes', es, s, ed, and ing and look at punctuation such as question marks and exclamation marks. Daily phonics lessons will continue.

Science
