The children will study about the explorers Christopher Columbus and Amelia Earhart. They will look at their achievements and how they impacted the world.

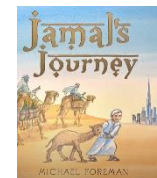


Computing (computers and iPads)
