

English

Children will read Toga in a tangle and carry out role play activities to help them understand the Felix's journey to save Rome.

Children will write character descriptions and setting descriptions using expanded noun phrases and different sentence types.

Art and Design – In art children will create a Roman Mosaic tile. They will have the opportunity to discuss designs and evaluate their own creation.

At the Roman Fort – They will sculpt a clay tea light.

Music



Musical skills practised through songs and instruments with the music teacher.

Children will learn to play the glockenspiel and drums in rhythm to famous songs. They will learn about songs from different cultures.

Science

Skeletons- We will be learning about skeletons and why we have them in our body. We will understand the difference between endoskeletons and exoskeletons. We will then look into why we have different shaped bones and how our joints are connected to our muscles.

History - Children will study the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. This will include the power of its army, Julius Caesar and the attempted invasions of Britain and the "Romanisation" of Britain.

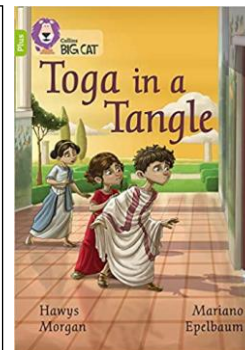
Geography – Children will carry out human geography, where they will research about how Romans lived, their settlements and the types of weapons they made and used.
