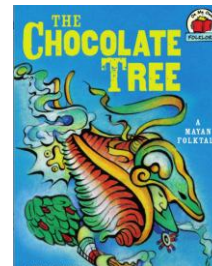

Music



Children will have the opportunity to review and practise their music skills through songs and instruments.

They will be using the Ukelele to explore music from different countries and cultures.



History

Children will continue with their topic of The Maya Civilisation. They will be focusing on how the Maya lived and what their diet was like. This will lead to the children having the opportunity to taste chocolate and fruit linked to this topic!

Art Children will study Mayan motifs and patterns. They will learn about surface texture using mixed media and experiment with oil pastels on black card to blend colours. They will also learn about printing and the different types eg. dry point, monoprint, woodcut, lithograph. Then they will design their own print using influence from the ancient motifs.



Maths

In Maths, children will be working on Multiplication and Division. Then moving onto 'Length & Perimeter'. They will be measuring and comparing lengths in mm, cm and m. As part of this unit, they will also be adding and subtracting lengths.
