Science - Plants



Children will learn to pot, plant seeds and look after their plants. They will be able to name parts of the plants confidently and explain their purpose. Children will have the opportunity to see how water travels up a plant and it's importance. The children will begin to understand the processes of pollination and fertilisation in a plant. Children will also study and understand the importance of the life cylcle of a plant.

Art

Children will be using watercolours and paint to help create textured pictures of fruit from around the world. They will be looking at how to blend colours to add tone and depth to their pictures. We will also be studying work by the artist Guiseppe Arcimboldo.



Geography

In Geography, we will be looking at the UK. We will be focusing on physical features such as rivers, seas, hills and mountains before moving on to study human features from across all parts of the UK. Children will have the opportunity to research how the city of London has developed over time.



Maths

Fractions: Children will be able to understand and show what a ½, ¼, 1/3, 1/8, 1/10 look like with objects and numbers. They will be able to show how to place fractions on a number line and compare and order fractions.

Mass & Capacity Children will be looking at different units of measurement (grams, kilograms, millilitres, litres). They will be adding and subtracting units of measurement, as well as converting and comparing them.
