Story: Use video literacy to retell a story using ambitious vocabulary which link with the visuals in the video. We will study expanded noun phrases, conjunctions, prepositions and the different forms of writing. Capital letters, finger spaces and punctuation (. ? !) must be used accurately.

Fact file: Read and enjoy The Rhythm of the Rain by doing drama and oracy activities to empathise and understand what the characters are feeling and what is like to follow the journey of a river from its source.

Computing (computers and iPads)

Online Safety- Children will learn about how to stay safe online at school and at home. They have the opportunity to discuss who would be their trusted adult.

Coding – We will be reinforcing and building on the children's current coding skills; creating movement and even games.

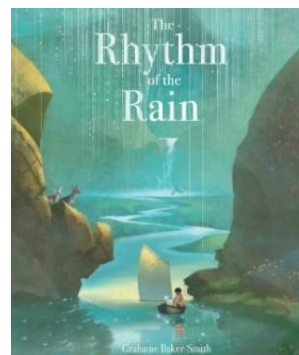


Music
