English

This half term we will be writing a character description of Little nose. We will look at how to write a character description. We will focus on strong vocabulary and grammar form.

We will also be reading a poem about winter. We will be using a picture of a winter scene to base our poem on and will be exploring vocabulary linked to winter.

Computing



This half term we will be using Purple Mash to explore the skills of coding; creating simple programmes to solve challenges

French

This half term children will be learning days of week and months of the year. The main focus is on speaking.

P.E. Gymnastics and invasion Games

Learning football skills and using them in game situations.

Science:

In science we will be explore a variety of everyday materials and develop simple descriptions of the states of matter. Children will compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases They will observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C). Finally, they will recap on water cycle.

Music



We will be using the Charanga scheme to learn glockenspiel skills. We will study musical notation, pulse and other technical skills.



DT

Children will research how Stoneage settlements were made and from what materials. They will discuss and experiment with different materials that they could use to create our own. Children will then sketch their ideas and learn how to handle equipment and materials safely. Finally, they will evaluate their work.

History



Changes to Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age

History, looking long ago at first peoples in Britain, how they lived, their tools, homes, clothes. How technology and people's live have changed in this long period of history.

Maths:

In maths children will be studying multiples of 3,6,9 ,9,11 and 12 times table and division facts. They will use multiplication facts to solve problem solving and reasoning questions.
