History- The Victorians

We will be studying the Victorians and learning about what life was like in this era. We will discover what happened during the industrial revolution and how the textiles industry impacted our country. A visit to Armley Mills will take place in in Autumn 2.



Music Rhythm and Sounds. Vocabulary focus: dynamics, tempo, pitch, pulse and rhythm, texture, structure and timbre.

Science - Earth and Space

In science we will describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system; describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth; describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies; use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky
