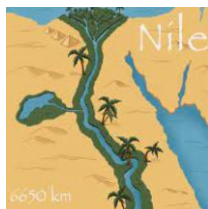
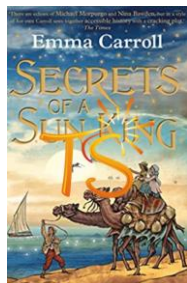

Science

Changing Materials

We will be comparing the properties of different materials, separating mixtures of materials based on their properties, irreversible and reversible changes and melting and freezing of different materials.



Music

This term we are going to continue spending time developing skills to help us compose pieces of music. We will be studying musical vocabulary such as timbre, pitch, volume, tone, pulse, and rhythm and identifying these in modern and historic music. We will appraise music and discuss our own thoughts, feelings, and emotions. We will be singing theme songs.

Art and Design We will be making mod-roc Egyptian death masks and learning how bread is made. Art and design technology will focus on our theme, Ancient Egyptians.

History - Children will continue study Ancient Egypt. They will be learning about family life, making bread, and discovering the Egyptian Gods and Goddesses.

Geography - Children will be looking at the cities of Ancient Egypt and the geography of The River Nile.

Computing Skills

We will learn all about databases and how computer software helps us to solve everyday problems.

Reading - books are changed when needed and Reading Plus should be completed for 30 minutes a week at home.
