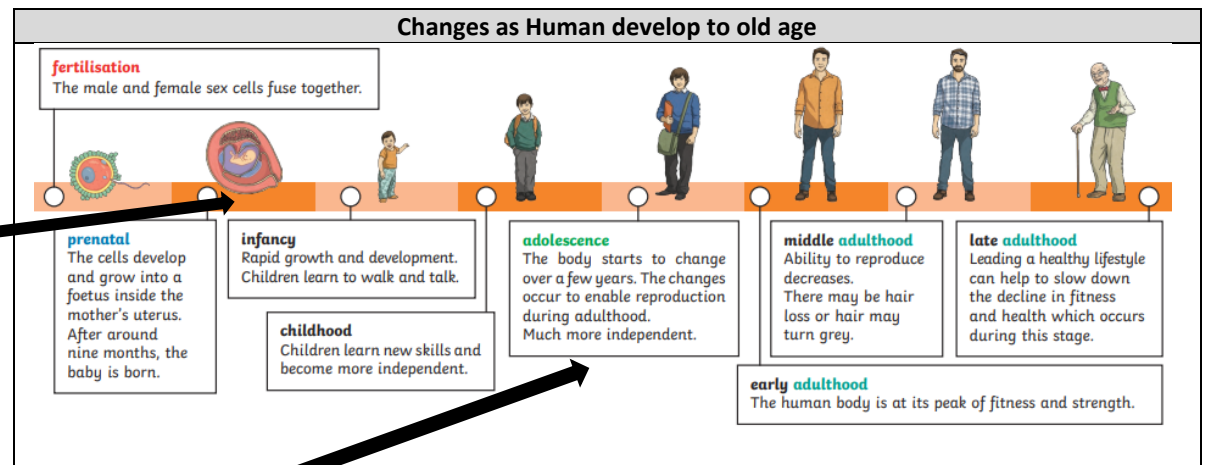


## Year 5 Animals including Humans

Key Vocabulary	
Foetus	An animal or human being in its later stages of development before it is born.
Adolescence	The period of your life in which you develop from being a child into being an <b>adult</b> .
Hormones	A chemical usually occurring naturally in your body that makes an <b>organ</b> of your body do something.
Gestation	The process in which babies grow inside their mother's body before they are born.
Viviparous	Give birth to live young rather than laying eggs.
Puberty	A big growth spurt between the age of 10 and 13 years old when the body changes.



- A change that happens in late **childhood** and **adolescence** where the body starts to change because of **hormones**.
- Boys and girls will undergo **physical changes** as they get older. They can increase in height and weight, they may get acne or spots and their moods can change regularly.

Boys	They may grow body and facial hair; their voice can get deeper and their Adam's apple may start to protrude
Girls	Their body fat may increase, including the widening of their hips.
