

 Girls Their body fat may increase, including the widening of their hips.




Gestation Period

Gestation periods are different for different mammals.











Between 2 and 8 weeks, when major **organs** and **structure** to the organism develop.











After eight weeks until birth when it takes on a recognisable human form and grows until it is ready to be born. This is called a **Foetus**.
