This half term our class novel will be based on Journey to the River Sea by Eva Ibbotson, Initially, we are going to take part in drama activities, then investigate new vocabulary, thinking about word definitions and use then to compose sentences. After this, we will be concentrating on imagery and figurative writing skills and using expanded noun phrases to prepare us for some descriptive writing. We know how supportive you are and we would really like the children to be able to share and use their new vocabulary at home too! In spelling, punctuation and grammar (GPaS) We will continue to learn and use the year 5/6 curriculum words and spelling rules and patterns. We will also consolidate our understanding of conjunctions and subordinate clauses as well as practising using parenthesis. In Year 5, we expect children to be able to comprehend what they are reading and we will be focusing on this during our guided reading comprehension sessions.

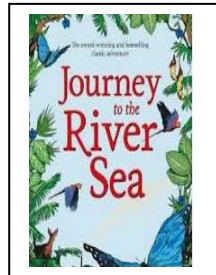
Science
