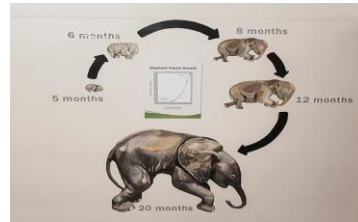
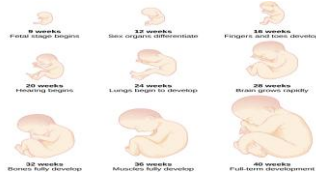
Children will learn about how their bodies change and grow throughout life.

Children will be learning about gestation periods for different mammals and how they change as they develop.



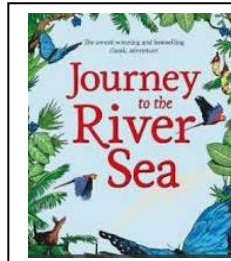
Music

French

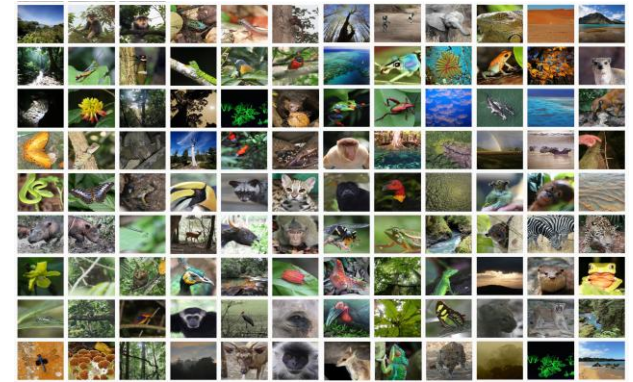
Using our foreign language learning platform (Language Angels) we will continue to study:
